Coming from three generations of theater performers, Army veteran and Bronze Star recipient Christopher Paul Meyer founded VetRep following his separation from the military in February 2021. Through an ongoing series of playwrighting competitions, VetRep assesses, develops, and mentors talented writers who must be current or former military, law enforcement, fire/EMS, foreign service, intelligence service, DoD contractors/employees, or an immediate family member. VetRep's programming includes weekly staged readings at VetRep's Parlor in Cornwall, NY, **Savage WonderGround immersive art performances** at unique venues along the East Coast, **the Savage Wonder Festival of Veterans in the Arts**, and readings/workshops of veteran-authored world premiere plays, in advance of future productions. VetRep also holds acting and writing workshops in order to develop more veteran artists in each media. VetRep's popular **Savage Wonder literary blog** and **Savage Wonder podcast** are both year-round productions. The literary blog focuses on veteran writers and poets, while the podcast features long-form, one-on-one conversations with veterans in a wide variety of artistic media.
